



Civilian Aircraft Access to the CLAWR

CIVAIR 38-18

21-27 Sep 2018

CO 4 OSS authorizes the following aircraft access to the Cold Lake Air Weapons Range (CYR 204) for the period indicated, subject to the restrictions indicated.

All aircraft must be aware of any and all active fire grids and associated constraints prior to entry, and **must monitor 126.7 and Sentry** while in the CLAWR.

ATC Tower shall ensure that all aircraft entering the CLAWR prior to End of Local Flying (ELF) must contact WOPs RAPTOR @ 8769 prior to entry.

***Note: All aircraft must contact 4 Wing ATC and the ECC on entry and exit to the CYR 204 (CLAWR). The ECC can be contacted by radio or alternatively by phone at 780-815-6642.**
